

Chemical Detox for Firefighters

Fire fighting is the only profession in North America where an employee cannot legally refuse to work under dangerous or toxic conditions.

In 2006 Medical Researchers at the University of Cincinnati published definitive evidence that firefighters are at greater risk of Multiple Myeloma, non Hodgkins Lymphoma, Prostate and testicular cancers. (1)

In 2006 U.S. Medical Doctors also published the first sweat detoxification study showing dramatic improvement for 273 New York Firefighters suffering from chronic lung, heart and thyroid malfunction after working in the smoldering embers of the World Trade Center. (2)

It is now understood that sweating is the firefighter's number one defense against illness.

In 2007 the World Health Organization officially declared the profession to be a "Possible Human Carcinogen". Fire fighting was placed on the Class 2b Carcinogen list along with exposure to lead, DDT, and formaldehyde. (3)

For the 21st Century fire fighter, the high risk of cancer is now as real as a collapsing roof.

In 2009 the U.S. National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) determined that fire fighters have an elevated risk of Cancer based on a definitive study that followed the health of 30,000 American firefighters over a period of 60 years. (4)

In 2010 Medical Doctors in Canada discovered human sweat contains high concentrations of phthalates⁽⁵⁾, bisphenol A⁽⁶⁾, and heavy metals⁽⁷⁾ – the same toxins that are making firefighters sick.

This discovery paved the way for chronic illness and Cancer Prevention in the firefighter profession.

Today most provincial and state governments across North America have adopted "presumptive legislation" for more than a dozen cancers and heart disease.

Fire services focusing on employee wellness are embracing the SaunaRay Detox system for fire fighters. It combines gentle infrared medical grade heaters with mild exercise on a stationary bike to coax a quick and profuse sweat without raising the core body temperature. How it works

Like Being in a Greenhouse: Our Medical Grade ceramic elements work like a "greenhouse" by concentrating the heat in the infrared spectrum. It is easy to breathe in the gentle warm air, but you sweat profusely and detoxify more swiftly than any other proven method.

SaunaRay chemical detox chambers employ "far infrared" heating technology that promotes human sweat without raising the core body temperature. They have been trusted in medical studies and are the industry standard in Naturopathic teaching colleges across North America.

Comfortable Heat: Traditional sweat chambers require super high heats of 180F (80C). This causes the side effect of over-heating, and potential toxic flush into the bloodstream. SaunaRay's unique infrared heating systems operate below core body temperature 78-100F (27-40C). This means accumulated toxins do not re-enter the blood stream, and instead are expelled via sweat.

All Natural: Infrared heat comes naturally from the sun. It is perfectly mimicked using SaunaRay's medical grade ceramic infrared heating system. This allows people inside to sweat more quickly.

Cycling inside: Mild exercise on the stationary bicycle acts as a catalyst to generate a gentle sweat in seven minutes and a profuse detoxifying sweat in 15 minutes.

Medical Grade Construction: SaunaRay Chemical Detox chambers are made without toxic glues, plastics, chemical fire retardants, plywood or fiber board. 


